### Certificate Requirements



Courses for the
Undergraduate
Certificate in Asian
Studies are divided into
two Groups. Group A
consists of Art, Humanities, Religious Studies,

and Language and Group B includes courses from Geography, History, and International Studies/Political Science. The requirements are as follows:

- ♦ 18 credit hours from the courses listed by subject area
- ♦ At least 2 courses must be from Group A
- ♦ At least 2 courses must be from Group B
- Student must achieve a cumulative 2.5 GPA in the certificate program.
- You must also declare your intention to be awarded the Certificate by the fifth week of classes in the term in which you intend to graduate by submitting the Undergraduate Certificate in Asian Studies form to the Asian Studies Certificate advisor.
- Students are also required to submit a graded paper from any of the courses that are applying to the Asian Studies Certificate at the time of submitting their Asian Studies Certificate application.
- Please note that students may only use one language course towards the certificate requirements.
